## **SHORT SYNOPSIS**

Thailand. A young man in his thirties leads a very entertaining life full of parties. One day, just like 70% of men in his country, he decides to become a short-term monk. Ball has two weeks to find his peace and achieve his goal but the whole world seems to be distracting him.

### **DIRECTOR' STATEMENT**

My film was made at a time, when I was drifting away from the Catholic church. I was wondering what modern spirituality was made of – to what extent is it a result of a deeper need, and to what extent does it come from tradition and culture. After reading an article about Thai monks in a Polish magazine, I found out that in Thailand, a country miles away, things are not that different from Poland. For me it is a film about ready-to-use spirituality, about temporal life, and a lack of deeper thought on the meaning of existence, which seems to be a very common phenomenon in the modern world.

A graduate of the Directing Department of the Polish National Film School in Lodz. His films "52 percent" (Polish National Television, 2007), "Girls" (Polish National Television, 2009), "Play with me" (Polish National Television, 2010), "Lovers" (HBO, 2010) have been awarded and screened at many international festivals such as Cannes, IDFA Amsterdam, DOXA Vancouver, London, Lisbon, Toronto, Cracow, etc.

He has been awarded several scholarships for talented young artists in Poland, participated at the Berlinale Talent Campus and is a member of the Polish Film Academy.

### **PRODUCER**

**Centrala** - We focus on producing movies of young authors. We operate since 2004. Among others we produced following documentaries: The last day of summer (i.a. Golden Frog – Grand Grix – Camerimage, Remembrance and Future – GoEast), Gugara (i.a.
